Reed, Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas, a court of record within and for the said County and State, Daniel Ling, aged 85 years, a resident of Bedford Township, Bedford County, State of Pennsylvania, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he was married, that the name of his wife (who is now dead) was Mary Croyle, to whom he was married at Bedford Township, on the fourth day of April 1812; that he served the full period of sixty days in the military service of the United States in the War of 1812; that he is the identical Daniel Ling, who enlisted in Captain Hugh Gibson's Company Fourth Regiment (blank space) Brigade (blank space) Division, was stationed at Black Rock, was a private, went from Bedford to Pittsburg, from there to Meadville and from Meadville to Erie, and from Erie to Black Rock, where he was honorably discharged in December 1812..."

Daniel Ling was granted a pension of Eight dollars per month commencing February 14, 1871. Certificate No. 4975 was dated 22d Sept. 1871 and sent to Pension Agent.
